Small (in working condition): 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	Clean appliance
Small (scrap): 1, 3, 4	1 (\$5 fee); 4 (includes small motors & lawn equipment)
Batteries, Automobile: 1, 4, 12	(2 maximum)
Rechargeable household batteries: 13	
Bicycles (repairable): 14	Bikes are repaired and given to charities
(scrap): 1, 3, 4	
Books: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	
Building materials, cabinets, sinks, toilets, tubs, fixtures: 4	Usable items in fair condition (also small motors & lawn equipment)
Cans (aluminum or tin/steel): 1, 2, 3, 4	Rinse cans; labels are acceptable
Cardboard (corrugated cardboard only): 1, 2	Keep cardboard dry; collapse; remove plastics and polystyrene foam
Cell phones, pagers, PDAs: 17	
Clothing, linens, accessories: 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	Clean items
Computers & electronic equipment: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 15, 16	Must be late models in working order for donation
Electronic equipment scrap (stereos, computers, TVs, VCRs): 1, 4, 17	1 (\$5 fee per item); 4 (no TVs); 17 (\$10 fee per computer system)
Eyeglasses: 19	Prescription glasses
Furniture (clean & in good condition): 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	
(no longer usable): 1	\$5 fee small items; \$15 fee large items
Glass bottles and jars (mixed colors): 1, 2	Rinse glass; labels are ok; no lids, windows, Pyrex, glasses or dishes
Household hazardous waste (household cleaners, paints, kerosene, pharmaceuticals, pesticides, fertilizers, fluorescent bulbs, etc.): 1	Only on special drop-off day each autumn (Saturday 10/24 in 2009 from 8am to 1pm, combined with e-waste collection)
Household items: 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11	Clean and in working condition
Ink jet & laser cartridges: 17, 18	
Motor oil: 1, 12	12 (5 gallon maximum)
Oil (vegetable) & fat: 1	
Packing peanuts, bubble wrap, polystyrene foam blocks: 20	Items must be clean and intact
Paper (newspaper, office paper, magazines, phonebooks, bags, paperboard (i.e. cereal boxes)): 1, 2, 21	21 (no phone books) Keep paper dry; glossy ads, colored paper and staples are ok
Plastic containers (milk jugs, soda bottles, and similar): 1, 2	#1 & #2 on bottom of container; rinse and collapse; no lids or caps
Plastic grocery bags: 22, 23	May mix with other clean, thin, plastic bags; remove receipts
Scrap metal: 1, 3, 4	
Tires: 1	Up to 17.5"
Yard waste (in bags or bundles 4' length, 18" diameter max.): 1, 24	Loosely secure bags at top; 1 (branches can be 7' unbundled)

Reduce, Reuse and Recycle in Stillwater

Recycling facts:

- The average American creates 4.6 pounds of garbage each day or over 3 tons annually per family of four
- One ton of recycled paper saves 3,700 lbs of lumber and 24,000 gallons of water
- Recycling a soda can saves 96% of the energy used to make a can from ore
- Recycling employs 1.1 million people nationwide

How to reduce:

- Purchase items in bulk
- Avoid over-packaged products
- Choose durable goods over disposables
- Buy only what you need

Reuse & recycling tips:

- Save time and energy by visiting drop-off sites on your way to other destinations
- Maintain and repair items
- Compost yard waste and food waste
- Use a self-mulching mower and leave grass clippings on the lawn
- Make double-sided copies when printing
- Drink water from a reusable bottle
- Buy items with recycled content and “close the loop” by creating a market for recycled products

If in doubt, throw it out!

Non-recyclable items mixed in with similar materials that are recyclable may contaminate a load of material and make it unacceptable for processing. (If so, the entire load may be dumped in the landfill.) If in doubt, throw it out!

Self-service recycling drop-off sites:

Self-service sites are available 24 hours a day. Allied Recycling does not have facilities to sort items by category. Do not leave mixed materials. Call 377-3880 if bins are full. To report illegal dumping, call 742-8269 (public property) or 742-8383 (private property).
