- o Oct 26: City of STW Hazardous Waste Collection, also taking pharmaceuticals
- o November 15: America Recycles Day nation-wide promotion
- o September 21: H2Oklahoma in Stillwater
  - o Need volunteers at stations or for parking/registration
  - o At hydraulic lab, Lake Carl Blackwell.
  - Need tents, canopy water bottle donations, recycling containers and volunteers to take recycling
- o Trinity Homes LEED certified
  - o Jane Talkington will arrange home tour, date TBA
  - o Also coordinate with Junior League to get home on Stillwater Homes Tour
- Vineyard Tour at Woodland Park, date TBA

#### Recycling

- o Tour Recap: reporter showed up, manager MRF led tour
  - Few people sort by hand, large amounts of material not being recycled (tin, mixed plastics)
  - o New bins to come to recycling sites with better labels
  - o Allied to open new manned site at Marine Road facility for public.
  - Allied Waste responsible for overflowing containers, as well as records of what is recycled. SustSTW contacted city to inquire status of contractual agreement.

- o R&E Recycling takes aluminum and tin cans (any metal), cardboard and shrink wrap
  - o South on Perkins and 68<sup>th</sup> by Solitaire Homes, open T-F 8-4:30, Sat 8-noon
  - o No charge for bringing materials, pay for aluminum cans and other metal
  - o Also take large appliances and refrigerators with compressors removed
  - o Consider bulk delivery to site? Need space and transportation
- o Solid Waste Assn of No. Amer. (SWANA): conference Feb 28-29 Cherokee Casino
  - o Day 1: bus tour of facilities, Day 2: speaker sessions. Students attend free.
- Oklahoma Recycling Association (OKRA)
  - o Education Committee collecting resources and materials for teachers
  - Political Action Committee working with beverage container recycling bill, ban on electronic waste, and ban on yard/grass waste like Ponca City
  - o Collect yard waste separately and create composting facility, sell compost
  - o Website: www.recycleok.org
  - o Material exchange for large companies beginning in the region
- o Arkansas Recycling Association Conference: Sept 10-12 Eureka Springs
- o Labeling at Recycling Sites: Talk to city about picture examples on the bins of what can/not be recycled
  - Maybe on website or at sites
  - o DO NOT throw plastic bags in bins, take to Walmart or Albertsons
- o Committee could be formed to ban or charge for plastic shopping bags

## **Composting**

- o Norman has good model to follow, need to explore interest in community composting
  - o With automated pick-up, free up man power to go toward composting
  - o Contact David Higgins from Stillwater Public Works Department; see if OSU is interested; need volunteers for committee
- o Contact Mahesh Rao if interested
- o Also encourage composting and not bagging leaves at home
